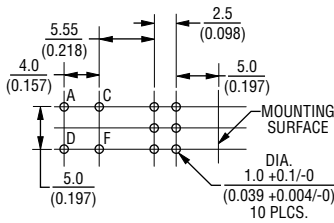




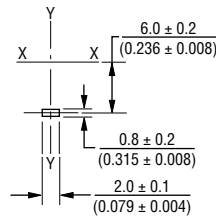

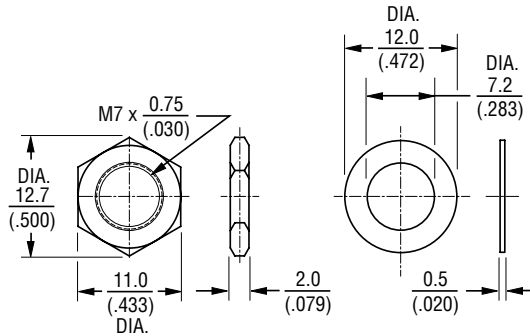
Mounting Hole Detail

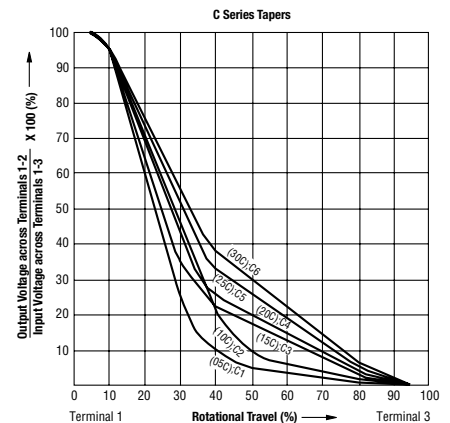
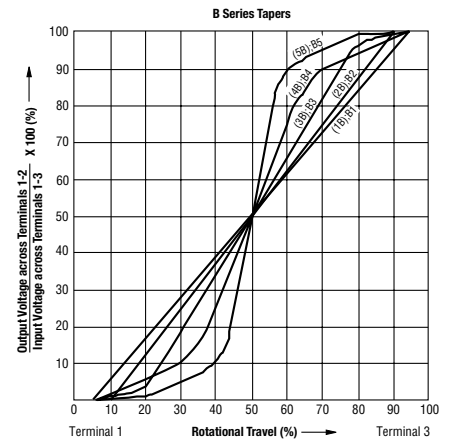
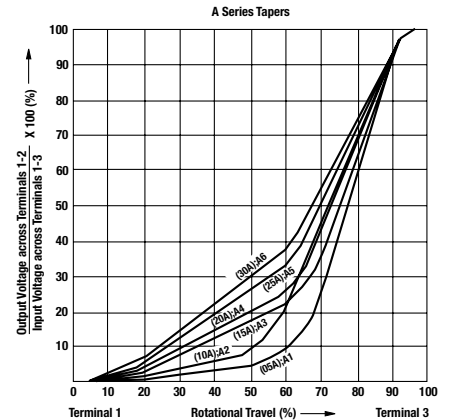


Schematic
